

JUNIOR GOLF PROGRAM

Our program focuses on age-appropriate instruction, fundamentals, and the traditions and etiquette of golf in a fun, social group setting. Emphasis is placed on proper pace of play and building a strong foundation rather than simply the number of holes played.

Age Groups (as of June 1):

- Ages 6-7: 1 hole
- Ages 8-9: 3 holes
- Ages 10-11: 5 holes
- Ages 12-13: 7 holes
- Ages 14-18: 9 or 18 holes

Juniors with birthdays during the series may choose their group. All groups compete in a season-long points competition with a prize for the top finisher.

- Friday July 17th will be a clinic day
- Championship Is Friday, July 24th

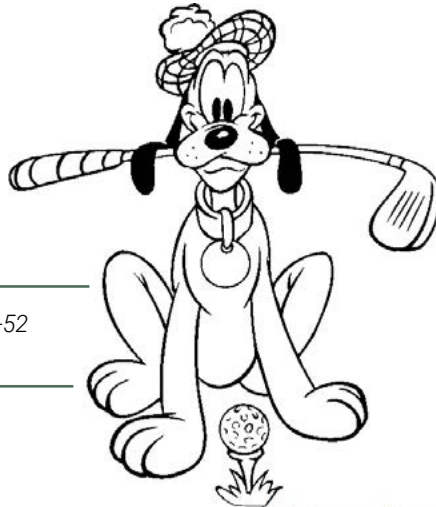

JR. TENNIS RECREATION PATHWAY

Our Junior Tennis Recreation Pathway introduces players ages 4-12 to the game through fun, games-based learning that builds athletic skills, confidence, and a lifelong love of racquets. Programs are designed to match age and ability, helping players progress at a comfortable pace.

PROGRAM LEVELS:

Red Squad 1 (Ages 4-5): Pre-rally clinic for beginners, developing agility, balance, coordination, and basic sending and receiving skills.

Red Squad 2 (Ages 6-7): Introduction to serving, rallying, and scoring using a rally-based curriculum.

Orange Squad (Ages 8-10): For advanced beginners and intermediates, focusing on topspin, depth, direction, volleys, and point-play concepts.

Green Squad (Ages 10-12): Designed for players transitioning to competitive play, emphasizing movement, stroke production, spin, and tactical point construction.

Yellow Squad (Skill Group): For middle and high school players at the yellow ball level, focusing on rally consistency, positioning, spin, and competitive match play.

JR. PICKLEBALL RECREATION PATHWAY

Our Junior Pickleball Recreation Pathway introduces players to the game through fun, games-based learning that builds coordination, confidence, and strong fundamentals. Programs are designed by age and skill level to support steady development and a love for the sport.

PROGRAM LEVELS:

Bronze Squad (Ages 7-9 / Skill): Focus on fundamentals such as sending, receiving, catching, and tracking, while learning positioning, rules, and scoring through a rally-based curriculum.

Silver Squad (Ages 10-12): Builds on fundamentals with games-based learning, emphasizing basic strategy, improved positioning, shot selection, and situational point play.

Gold Squad (Skill Group): Designed for competitive players looking to develop advanced shots, tactics, spin, pace variation, and strategic point construction in preparation for interclub, high school, and tournament play.

IGC GATORS JUNIOR SWIM TEAM

The Gators Junior Swim Team is a fun, competitive program where swimmers build strong technique, confidence, and lasting friendships in an energetic team environment. The Gators welcome both new and experienced swimmers. Team suit, swim cap, and basic swim gear required. Age 5+



WHAT TO EXPECT:

- Weekly practices focused on skill development, technique, and team spirit
- Wednesday evening meets with fun, energy, and friendly competition
- Pre-meet warm-ups to prepare swimmers to race
- Season runs early June through July, ending with the conference championship.

SKILL REQUIREMENT

Swimmers must be able to complete 25 yards of kick (one length of the pool) without stopping or assistance. Lessons are recommended for those still building skills.
